## 1 Kriterien Rainbow Index

<p><b>Kriterium:</b> Equality <b>action plan (sexual orientation)</b> covers action plans which expressly include sexual orientation, and include specific measures for progress. In addition, we only take into account when the action plan either entails or is followed up with the following measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Detailed projects or initiatives within the time span</li><li>• Allocation of resources (financial or human resources)</li><li>• Clear responsibilities for proper implementation</li><li>• Setup of monitoring procedure</li></ul>	<p><b>Definition</b> <i>sexual orientation</i>: Refers to each person's capacity for profound affection, emotional and sexual attraction to, and intimate and sexual relations with, individuals of a different gender or the same gender or more than one gender.</p>
<p><b>Kriterium:</b> Equality <b>action plan (gender identity)</b> covers action plans which expressly include gender identity, and include specific measures for progress. Equivalent grounds (sexual identity, gender reassignment, etc) accepted too. In addition, we only take into account when the action plan either entails or is followed up with the following measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Detailed projects or initiatives within the time span</li><li>• Allocation of resources (financial or human resources)</li><li>• Clear responsibilities for proper implementation</li><li>• Setup of monitoring procedure</li></ul>	<p><b>Definition</b> <i>gender identity</i>: Refers to each person's deeply felt internal and individual experience of gender, which may or may not correspond with the sex assigned at birth, including the personal sense of the body (which may involve, if freely chosen, modification of bodily appearance or function by medical, surgical or other means) and other expressions of gender, including dress, speech and mannerisms. Some people's gender identity falls outside the gender binary, and related norms</p>

<p><b>Kriterium: Equality action plan (sex characteristics)</b> covers action plans which expressly include sex characteristics, and include specific measures for progress. In addition, we only take into account when the action plan either entails or is followed up with the following measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Detailed projects or initiatives within the time span</li> <li>• Allocation of resources (financial or human resources)</li> <li>• Clear responsibilities for proper implementation</li> </ul>	<p><b>Definition <i>sex characteristics</i>:</b> A term that refers to a person's chromosomes, anatomy, hormonal structure and reproductive organs. OII Europe and its member organisations recommend protecting intersex individuals by including sex characteristics as a protected ground in anti-discrimination legislation. This is because many of the issues that intersex people face are not covered by existing laws that only refer to sexual orientation and gender identity. This is seen as being a more inclusive term than 'intersex status' by many intersex activists, as it refers to a spectrum of possible characteristics instead of a single homogenous status or experience of being intersex.</p>
